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Lincoln Christian School Uniform Dress Code

Overview

The level of respect we exhibit in our attire shows up in the classroom, hallways, and at school events. At Lincoln Christian School, we take school seriously, so we approach education by demonstrating respect for ourselves and respect for others in the way we dress.

We are disciplined in our approach; therefore, our dress code reflects that discipline.

General Appearance

- All clothing should be clean and maintained—Cut-offs, rips, holes, and fashion tears are not permitted). Clothing should cover completely and fit well excessively oversized and tight, body-hugging clothing is not permitted.
- Hair should be neat and well kept, not calling undue attention to the individual.
- Hats, hoods, and sunglasses are not permitted inside the buildings during the academic day unless approved
- Visible tattoos and body piercings (other than ears) are not allowed.
- During the school day and while in the classroom, only approved optional layers may be worn. Heavy coats, raincoats, and other forms of outerwear may be worn to and from lunch and recess; however, these items may not be taken to or worn during class.

Dress Code At a Glance

- Tops: Oxfords or Polos
- Bottoms: Pants or Shorts; Skirts (girls); Jumpers and Skorts (PK3-6 grades only)
- Additional Layers: Cardigan, Full Zip, Sweater Vest, ¼ Zip, Hoodie, or Crewneck Sweatshirt/Sweater
- Shoes: Athletic shoes (all grades) or shoes that enclose heel and toes (7-12th grades only)

C&J Uniforms is the standard guide for LCS uniforms; however, uniforms may be purchased elsewhere.

Tops

Polos or Oxfords

Style Options:

Collared polo or oxford (long or short sleeve)

Color Options:

Solid color in Black, Cardinal, Grey, Light Blue, Light Pink, Navy, (flat) Vegas Gold, White. Sheer shirts are not permitted.

Branding Marks & Logos:

Logos and branding marks are allowed if they are in the approved colors of Black, Cardinal, Grey, Light Blue, Light Pink, Navy, (flat) Vegas Gold, and White, and if they are smaller than a credit card. However, please note that the LCS logo is not permitted on light blue or navy shirts, while all other logos on those colors are acceptable.

Examples:

Long-Sleeved Oxford	Short-Sleeved Polo	Long-Sleeved Polo

Bottoms

Pants, Shorts, Skirts (Girls), Jumpers (PK3-6 Girls), or Skorts (PK3-6 Girls)

Style Options:

Girls may wear a box-pleat skirt or choose flat-front pants or shorts. Skorts or jumpers for PK3-6 girls only.

Boys may wear flat-front pants or shorts. PK3-6 grades may wear uniform elastic waist shorts or pants.

Color Options:

Black, Khaki, Grey, Navy; Skirts and jumpers can also be LCS Plaid (C&J is the only place to purchase LCS plaid.)

Length:

The length of shorts, skirts, skorts, or jumpers must be no more than 3 inches above the kneecap while standing.

Examples:

Boys (Flat Front)	Girls (Flat Front)	Shorts (Flat Front)
Skirt (Box Pleat)	Skort (PK3-6th Grade Only)	Jumper (PK3-6th Grade Only)

Additional Layers

Cardigan, Full Zip, Sweater Vest, ¼ Zip, Hoodie, or Crewneck Sweatshirt/sweater

Style Options:

Cardigan, Full Zip, Sweater Vest, ¼ Zip, Hoodie, or Crewneck Sweatshirt/Sweater. Crop tops are not permitted.

Color Options:

Solids in Black, Cardinal, Grey, Light Blue, Light Pink, Navy, (flat) Vegas Gold, and White

Branding Marks & Logos:

Permitted if they are in the colors of Black, Cardinal, Grey, Light Blue and Pink, Navy, (flat) Vegas Gold, and White, and are smaller than a credit card. Lincoln logos of any size are approved.

Undershirt Options:

A Polo or Oxford must be worn under Cardigans, Full Zips, or Sweater Vests.

A Solid-Colored T-shirt, Polo, or Oxford in Black, Cardinal, Grey, Light Blue, Light Pink, Navy, (flat) Vegas Gold, or White must be worn under ¼ Zip, Hoodie, or Crewneck Sweatshirt/Sweater.

If the student elects to remove this optional layer during class, the student must still be in the dress code (Polo or Oxford must be worn).

Coats & Outerwear:

During the school day and while in the classroom, only approved optional layers may be worn. Heavy coats, raincoats, and other forms of outerwear may be worn to and from lunch and recess; however, these items may not be taken to or worn during class.

Examples:

Cardigan	Full Zip	Sweater Vest
1/4 Zip	Hoodie	Crewneck Sweatshirt

Shoes

Athletic shoes (all grades) or shoes that enclose heels and toes (7-12th Grades only)

Elementary [PK3-6 grades]:

Elementary students must wear athletic shoes every day.

Secondary [7-12 grades]:

Athletic shoes, shoes that enclose the heel and toes, and boots that do not come above the knees may be worn. Sandals, backless, open-toed shoes, house shoes, and Crocs are not allowed. No shoes with heels or soles higher than 1-1/2". Footwear must be worn at all times.

Examples:

Yes- Tennis Shoes (All Grades)	Yes- Boots (7-12th grades only)	Yes - Heel & Toes Enclosed
No- Sandals	No- backless shoes or house shoes	No- Crocs

Socks

Socks should be a solid, neutral color (no patterns) that coordinate with the school uniform. Socks must be worn but are not to be worn above the knee. Small logos in approved colors are acceptable.

Leggings & Tights

Girls can wear leggings and tights underneath skirts, jumpers, and skorts in Black, Cardinal, Grey, Light Blue, Light Pink, Navy, (flat) Vegas Gold, and White.

Belts

Belts may be worn in Black or Brown (no patterns).

Spirit Day Attire

Last Day of the School Week

Jeans may be worn on the last day of the school week as long as they are worn with any Lincoln Christian School shirt. Jeans should be a solid color, denim blue jeans with no rips, holes, fashion tears, or frays. Students who choose not to wear spirit wear may not wear jeans.

Extracurricular Activities

At Lincoln Christian School functions, students may wear more relaxed attire that fits within the following guidelines:

Athletic-style shorts may be worn. When standing with arms extended straight down the side and making a fist, the short length must extend past the fist and be longer in the front and back. Shorts must be visible below the shirt.

Jeans must adhere to the guidelines of the dress code.

Yoga pants, leggings, or jeggings may be worn to after-school events only when worn with tops that extend past a closed fist when arms are extended to the side and encircle the front and back while standing or moving.

All skirts and dresses must meet the minimum guidelines of 3 inches above the knee when standing.

Excessively oversized and tight, body-hugging clothing is not permitted.

Field Trips

Elementary (Pre-K-6 grades) will be required to wear an LCS crimson polo, purchased from any retailer, for field trips.
