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The night of the event:

- All guests must have a picture ID to get into the event.
- The school reserves the right to refuse entrance to any guest of the event.
- All attendees are expected to follow Lincoln Christian School rules and LCS Code of Conduct always.

All students attending the event are expected to know that appropriate behavior is required and that all school rules are enforced at any activity sponsored or supported by Lincoln Christian School. All students and parents should be aware of the following specifics regarding school activities.

1. Any student found to be: in possession of, using, or under the influence of any controlled substance, alcoholic beverage, or intoxicant of any kind will be removed, and authorities will be notified.
2. Any vehicle, including limousines, may be searched.
3. Any student removed from the dance because of misbehavior before, during, or immediately after the dance may be excluded from any other Lincoln Christian School related activity for the remainder of the school year. Activities include, but are not limited to, athletic events, senior activities, commencement ceremony, etc.
4. All guests must complete a guest permission form and turn it in. All Lincoln Christian School students sponsoring a guest are responsible for the behavior of the guest.
5. Any student whose behavior adversely affects the experience of another participant (i.e. heckling, shouting, use of racial or other inappropriate epithets and slurs, etc.) or who damages property may be removed and/or excluded from any other Lincoln Christian School related activity.
6. Dress must be event appropriate. Students who are not appropriately dressed may be turned away at the door. Any dress pictures submitted are done so with the understanding that approval for attendance could be denied. For prom, dress approval is required. ***Note: It is the LCS student's responsibility to give dress guidelines to the guest; however, dress approval does not guarantee approval to attend.***
7. Dancing must be appropriate. Inappropriate dancing may result in a student being asked to leave the event.

Lincoln Christian School encourages families to discuss these rules together with their students.

“I understand all school events are drug, alcohol, and tobacco free. I agree to remain drug, alcohol, and tobacco free at this school event. Furthermore, I have read, understand, and agree to follow the above rules pertaining to behavior at school events. I understand the consequences for any inappropriate behavior. I also understand that if I am dancing inappropriately, I may be asked to leave the event without a refund of my ticket. I must be dressed appropriately to be admitted to the event. I understand that there will be no refunds after the event.”

In case of emergency involving my child, I understand every effort will be made to contact me. In the event I cannot be reached, I hereby give my permission to the medical provider selected by the adult leader in charge to secure proper treatment, including hospitalization, anesthesia, surgery, or injections of medication for my child. Medical providers are authorized to disclose to the adult in charge examination findings, test results, and treatment provided for purposes of medical evaluation of the participant, follow-up and communication with the participant's parents or guardian, and/or determination of the participant's ability to continue in the program activities.

All guests must have this form completed and on file to attend the event. Students without a contract on file, signed by the student, parent, and sending school, will not be admitted to the event.
